
OUR HISTORY FROM THE FOUNDATION OF ATATURK UNIVERSITY TREATMENT OF CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASES TO ANATOLIAN KIDNEY FOUNDATION AND OUR CONTRIBUTIONS TO NEPHROLOGY

n 1995, The Foundation of Atatürk University Treatment of Chronic Kidney Diseases, which delivered important services in the eastern region, was relocated in Ankara and renamed as Anatolian Kidney Foundation to serve better and expand its services nationwide. A Health, Education, Research Center was established within the foundation. Chronic Diseases and Hypertension Polyclinic was also established A project was organized 'for early diagnosis and treatment of patients with Chronic Kidney Diseases.' Health check-ups were carried out in Gümüşhane, which was chosen as a pilot area.

Our foundation, which obtained "LIVE AND LET LIVE" as a slogan, started to issue a newspaper called "Renaliz", every four months with mere educational purposes informing of nephrological news. It is the first scientific Nephrological newspaper in Turkey which is broadly admired. Renaliz analyzes every subject in nephrology in a detailed fashion. The 48 th issue will be issued soon.

When did I decide to write Turkish History of Nephrology? 1995

- Use to have any accessible material or article about the history of Turkish Nephrology and no one knew what others were doing. Therefore, I started to write it down thinking that "If one does not know about one's past, he cannot know about his future" I sent for the academicians in different clinics, who dealt with Nephrology.
- □ I called them over and over. I faxed them. We didn't have e-mail then.
- □ I tried to collect general information and I interviewed those who could not answer by visiting them at their places.

□ I tried to contact Ministry of Health and other institutions, such as Social Security

The book , *Turkish History of Nephrology*, was completed first as *Dialysis in Our Country*, then as Dialysis Transplantation, and finally as Turkish History of Nephrology, which became one of the mostly wanted books in the field.

□ A Summary" (2003) was written and published by Ayla SAN.

- Turkish History of Nephrology was updated and presented by Prof. Dr. Ayla San for the national and international congresses on The Turkish History of Medicine in 2008 and 2012.
- □ On 20-21 September 2013, 8th IAHN, International Association for the History of Nephrology, Congress in Ancient Olympia, Greece Ayla San presented "Nephrological Knowledge in Turkey During the 18th, 19th and Early 20th Centuries".



The problems arising from the increase in the number of hemodialysis centers and solutions were discussed. Its book was published in 2003.



Due to the changes in the regulations, the failure of economic situation, the stability of the prices of hemodialysis and the increase in the number of centers leading to serious problems caused us to organize this symposium 6 years later.

The Fifth Symposium on Hemodialysis and Quality 26-29 April 2012 CYPRUS




