

# 2016 European Kidney Forum "Moving from disease care to health care – A paradigm shift that focuses on Prevention"

On the 19th of April, the European Kidney Health Alliance organised its annual multistakeholder Forum, co-hosted by the MEP Group for Kidney Health. The event was the occasion to debate the need for an overhaul in healthcare systems, in order to shift from disease care to prevention. Participants discussed measures to reduce the prevalence of chronic diseases, in particular chronic kidney disease, and on the related potential impact these actions can have in terms of health spending.

#### It's Never Too Early...To Prevent Diabetes

Women with a history of gestational diabetes, or diabetes that develops during pregnancy, have a 35 to 60 percent chance of developing diabetes—mostly type 2—in the next 10 to 20 years; and their children may have a greater chance of developing obesity and type 2 diabetes. If you had gestational diabetes, find out what you can do to prevent diabetes in the future.

#### What You Should Know about Bladder Control

Leaking urine is a common health problem for women of all ages. Find out what causes <u>bladder control problems</u> in women and what treatments are available.
