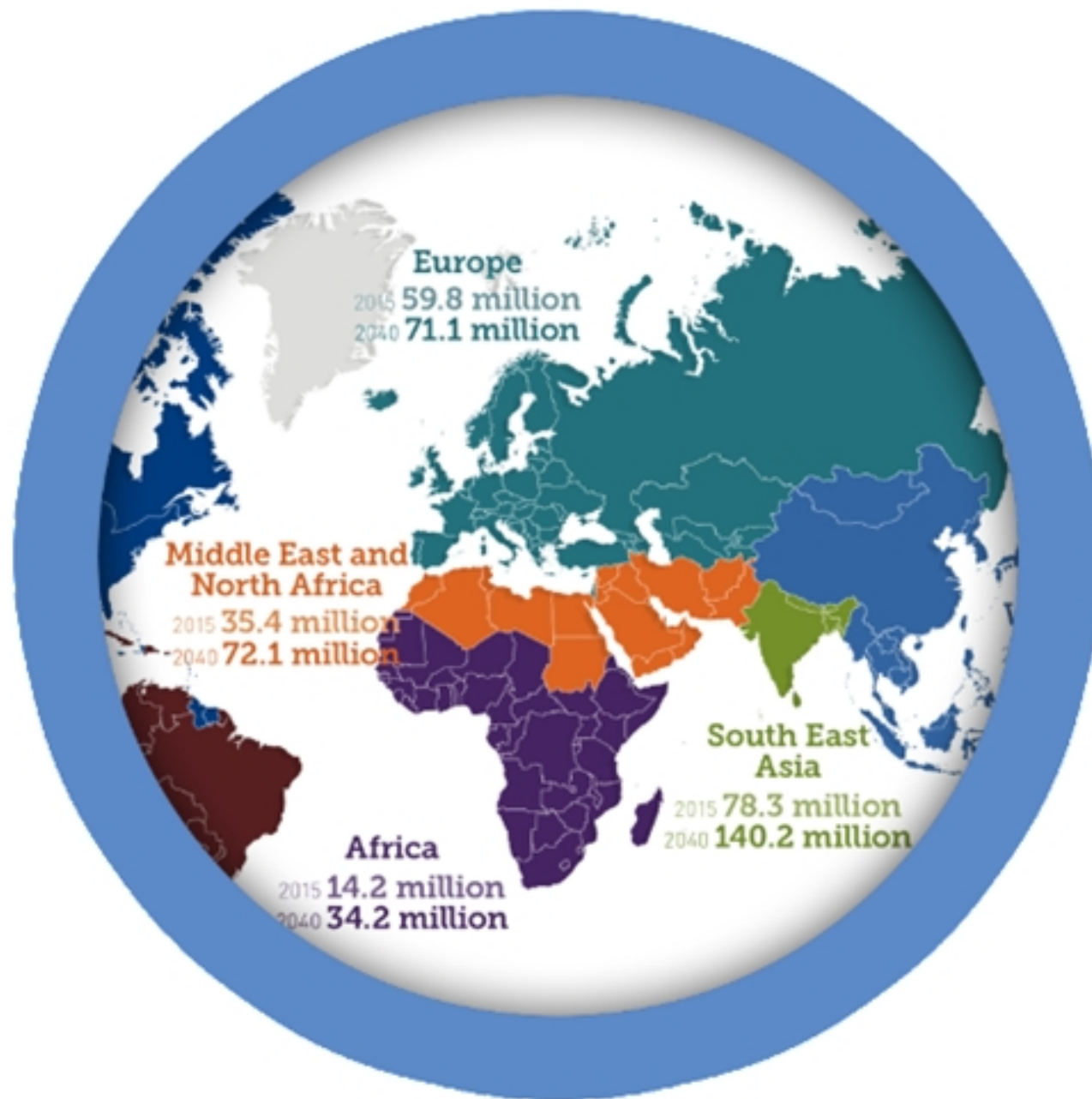
One in two adults with diabetes is undiagnosed. Screening for type 2 diabetes is important to ensure early diagnosis and treatment to reduce the risk of serious complications.
